FemPower (Feminist Power in Action for Women's Economic Rights) began as a simple yet radical idea—when women come together, when they share space, build connections, and strategize collectively, change becomes inevitable. Across borders, across struggles, we created a network of 42 women's rights organizations and young feminist leaders in Lebanon, Jordan, Palestine, and Tunis, determined to dismantle Economic Gender-Based Violence (eGBV).

This isn't just another program. It is a movement in the making. A movement built on trust, dialogue, and feminist methodologies that center women's realities, power, and agency. We didn't impose solutions—we co-created them. We listened. We learned by doing. We challenged systems that limit us, redefined power, and ensured that feminist values weren't just words but the foundation of everything we do.
